To amend the Radiation Exposure Compensation Act for purposes of making claims under such Act based on exposure to atmospheric nuclear testing, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Radiation Exposure
5 Compensation Act Amendments of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION UNDER THE RADIATION EXPOSURE**
2 **COMPENSATION ACT.**

3 Section 4(b)(1) of the Radiation Exposure Com-
4 pensation Act (42 U.S.C. 2210 note; Public Law 101-
5 426) is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (B)—

7 (A) by striking “that portion of”; and

8 (B) by striking “that consists of townships
9 13 through 16 at ranges 63 through 71”; and

10 (2) in subparagraph (C), by inserting “all acre-
11 age in any county all or part of which is located in”
12 before “that part”.

13 **SEC. 3. DENIAL OF CHARITABLE FOR CONTRIBUTIONS**
14 **THAT HAVE A PREREQUISITE FOR PUR-**
15 **CHASING TICKETS TO A COLLEGE SPORTING**
16 **EVENT.**

17 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 170(f) of the Internal
18 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end
19 the following:

20 “(1) CONTRIBUTIONS THAT HAVE A PRE-
21 REQUISITE FOR PURCHASING TICKETS TO A COL-
22 LEGE SPORTING EVENT.—No deduction shall be al-
23 lowed under subsection (a) for any contribution that
24 has a prerequisite for purchasing tickets to a college
25 sporting event.”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) shall apply to contributions made after the
3 date of the enactment of this Act in taxable years ending
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
